About The CK-550 _

The **CK-550 Conversion Kit** allows you to replace the low-profile, round knob (shown in Fig. 1) on the tilt mechanism of older Sidekicks and Wimberley Head models (WH-100 & WH-101) with the 5-lobe, soft-touch tilt knob found on the current Sidekick and Wimberley Heads.

The Philips head screw provided in this kit should fit most units; however if you experience a problem upon installation, please contact us.

Please remove the appropriate parts from your existing unit and install the new parts in the proper order.


NOTE: The screw in this kit is too long for installation on the Wimberley Head Version II & the Sidemount Head tilt. If you need to replace knobs on either of these Heads, please contact us. This knob is not compatible for the replacement of the panning knob on any unit.

Instructions -

Note: The drawings below show the Wimberley Sidekick®, however the same steps and hardware apply for retrofitting the tilt knob on original style Wimberley Heads, models WH-100 and WH-101.

Removing Your Existing Knob


- Remove the captivating screw (the screw that keeps the knob from backing all the way off) using a Phillips screwdriver as shown below.
- 2. Unscrew the knob, and be careful to keep the remaining parts in place. Once the knob is removed, there is nothing keeping the shaft from sliding out of the bearing housing; be sure the mechanism is held together until the new knob is installed.





Installing the New Knob

- 1. Install the aluminum washer on the shaft.
- 2. Install the new knob (oriented as shown in the diagram).
- 3. **Install the new, longer captivating screw** using a Phillips screwdriver. Drive the screw in until it bottoms out in the threaded hole. If this screw position does not allow the knob to be backed out at least one-half turn, back the captivating screw out a small amount.
